

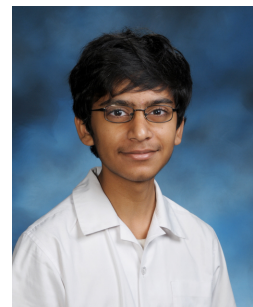

SOUTH ISLAND SCHOOL GCSE RESULTS

Students at South Island were celebrating today as The School released ‘best ever’ GCSE/IGCSE examination results to follow the outstanding IB and BTEC scores from July.

The average grade per subject rose to 6.64 and the total of A* and A grades reached 59.3% of all exams taken – an increase of more than 3% on last year’s record. Nearly 32% of all exams taken were passed at A*.

Four students scored 10A* or more - Garrick Wan (11.5), Ariq Hatibie (10.5), William Kwok (10.5) and Tarun Srivastava (10) and a total of 24 students scored 7 A* or better.
